#### <u>Attendance</u>

Attending school is very important and is mandatory for all school-aged children. Your child must attend school every day unless they are unwell. Children who are regularly absent from school miss out on opportunities which can affect their life-long chances. Good attendance is considered anything above 96%. An attendance of 90% or lower will be classed as a persistent absentee and this can have a significant impact on your child's learning. Please be aware that I have a statutory duty to make you aware when your child's attendance falls below this. Your child's attendance for the Autumn term has been included in their Autumn Term Report.

#### **Holiday Requests**

We have noticed an increase in the number of requests we have received for holidays during term time. The law states that a Head Teacher is unable to grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. We ask that parents complete a leave of absence form via Weduc and send via email any evidence of "exceptional circumstances" otherwise the request cannot be considered. I need to make you aware that unauthorised absences on your child's attendance records could result in you receiving a penalty notice from the local authority. 7 days of unauthorised absence in a 12-week rolling period must now be referred to the Local Authority for enforcement action.

Year 4 Multiplication Check	Schools must administer the multiplication tables check within the 2-week period from Monday 3 June 2024.	
Year 1 Phonic Screening Check	Schools must administer the phonics screening check within the 1-week period from Monday 10 June 2024.


#### **RECOMMENDED READS**


Jam-packed with animals and silliness, this original rhyming story will have young children in fits of laughter.
